



## Electronic Logging Device (ELD) Mandate

### Background

- 2012 MAP-21 mandated all commercial motor vehicles replace paper logs with Electronic Logging Devices (ELD) by Dec. 18, 2017.
- ELDs cost between \$200-\$1,000 per unit, plus \$30 - \$50 monthly service fee.
- ELDs record driving time and monitor engine hours, vehicle movement & speed, miles driven and location information.
- Electronically report data to federal and state inspectors.

### Concerns:

- Not compatible with agricultural exemptions.
- Replace paper logs and remove “flexibility” of old system.
- Put drivers at heightened risk of Hours of Service violations.



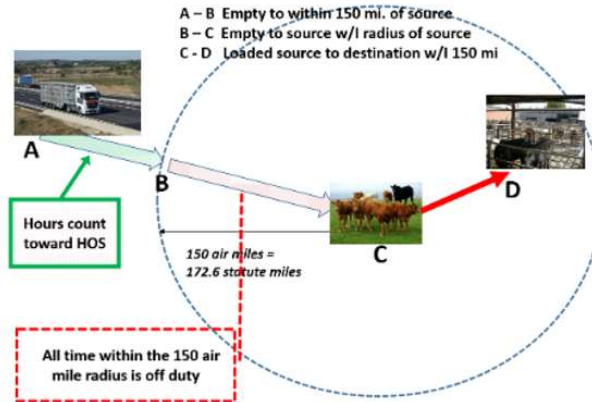
## Hours of Service Rules

  - Waiver Petition

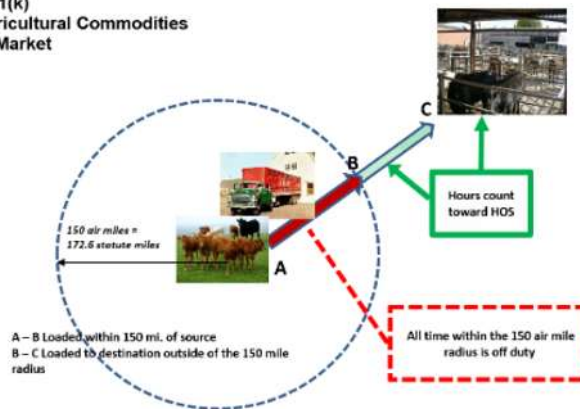
### En Route Empty to Source

#### 395.1(k) En route empty to source



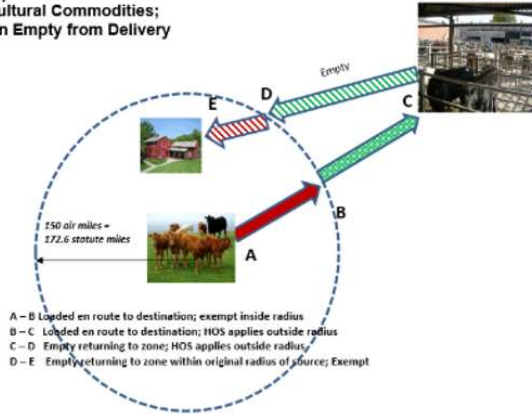

#### 395.1(k) Agricultural Commodities to Market



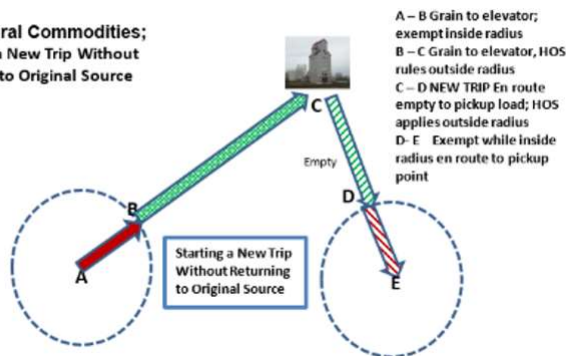
